User Manual

Ensure that the panel is facing south as much as possible.

Remember to clean the panel from time to time.

Do not place the panel in areas where shadows occur.

Do not charge behind glass!

Installation instructions:

1. Carefully select the installation location for the lamp. Try to avoid places with shadows during the day and places with other light sources at night, which could cause the product to malfunction (the product could be "tricked" and the light would not turn on). Poor lamp placement results in shorter lighting time at night.
2. Drill two holes in the base 34 mm apart and use the supplied fasteners or others depending on the type of surface.
3. Select the desired lighting mode by covering the solar panel and pressing the on/off button on the switch:

first press – full brightness

second press – energy saving mode (ideal for cold months or lamps located in sub-optimal locations)

Third press – off

4. Tighten the screws and slide the lamp down onto these screws.
5. The lamp will automatically turn on after dusk.

Troubleshooting

If the lamp is not working properly, it is more than likely that you will be able to solve the problem yourself. Placing the lamp's solar panel in an unsuitable location will result in the lamp not working properly.

Please try to solve the problem using the tips below before contacting your supplier:

1. Check the installation location of the panel again. Is it facing south as much as possible?
2. Are there any other light sources near the lamp at night that could send a misleading signal to the lamp that it is still daytime? Perform a quick test by covering the solar panel with a cloth or similar material so that no light falls on it. If the lamp activates and lights up, its operation at night is affected by some other external light source. Remove this light source or install it in a different location.

Maintenance

Clean the surface of the solar panel and bulb with a soft, slightly damp cloth. Do not use corrosive cleaning agents or chemical solutions, as they may damage the surface and impair the operation of the lamp.

Keep the solar panel clean and free of dirt such as mud, snow, etc., as this will prevent the lamp battery from charging properly. It may also shorten the battery life or cause the lamp to malfunction.
