


## USB heated socks

1. Charge the USB power bank of the heated socks until the 4 blue LED lights stop flashing. The charging time for an empty power bank is usually 4–6 hours.
2. Carefully connect the fully charged power bank to the heated socks.



3. Turn the USB power bank for heated socks on/off by holding the ON/OFF button for 3 seconds.
4. Set the desired heating level on the remote control or press the ON/OFF button once to change the temperature.
5. Three red LED lights (L M H) indicate the set heating level:
  - 3 LED lights – high (H)
  - 2 LED lights – medium (M)
  - 1 LED light – low (L)
6. You can check the battery level of the USB power bank during operation by quickly pressing the ON/OFF button once:
  - 1 LED light – capacity 0 to 25%
  - 2 LED lights – capacity 26 to 50%
  - 3 LED lights – capacity 51 to 75%
  - 4 LED lights – capacity 76 to 100%

### **WARNING:**

If you feel uncomfortable and the radiated heat causes a "tingling" sensation or your skin reddens, you may be getting burned. Immediately turn off the product and stop using it. Read the safety instructions carefully before use.

### **GENERAL ADVICE**

- Cold feet have poorer blood circulation, so do not let them "cool down" before using the product. The energy required to warm cold feet is higher and the desired effect may not be achieved.
- At low temperatures, you may not feel the warming effect of the product, but your feet will no longer be exposed to the cold.
- If you are unsure whether the product is working properly, try putting on only one sock. You will see if you feel any difference after 10-15 minutes.
- Prevent your feet from sweating in socks; sweat/moisture cools your feet.

### **SOCKS DO NOT WORK WITH THE REMOTE CONTROL**

1. Press the ON/OFF button on the USB power bank for 7 seconds until the three red LED lights start flashing.
2. Press the lowest button on the remote control to set the control to the USB power bank.

You can also use the steps described above if you purchase a new remote control.
